AIMS

1. The Australian Living Peace Museum aims to foster a culture of peace reflecting the multidisciplinary nature of peace efforts made personally by individuals and by organisations past and present. It intends to do this in accord with a range of local, national and international measures including disarmament, human rights, ecology, reconciliation (including indigenous responses to colonisation), education and the growth of international humanitarian law.
2. Establish an online museum interpreting the Australian history of peace making, using text, image and multimedia resources.
3. Develop educational resources relating to peace for use in Australian schools and provide a hub for peace education resources for the community.
4. Encourage a critical discussion within the media relating to peace and to provide an alternative voice on relevant issues – especially during the Centenary of WW I commemorations and beyond.
5. Collect and present oral histories of Australians and Australian organisations working towards peace.
6. Establish strong links with peace museums and other organisations working for peace in Australia and internationally.
7. Develop additional activities of a peaceful and educational nature.

ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP
